Further, the Vice-Chancellor also extended a vote of thanks to theoutgoing members Prof. Devinder Singh, Dr. Anil Khurana, Dr. Avdhesh KumarPandey, Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Prof. Asha GuptaandProf. Neeru Vasudeva for their valuable contribution.Thereafter, the agenda was taken up for discussion and deliberation.

1. Confirmed the minutes of the 58<sup>th</sup>meeting held on 22.07.2021 circulated vide letter No. Acad./AC-II/AC-58/2021/4293-4336Dated: 23.08.2021 with the following amendment in Resolution No. 22 (any other item) on the recommendations, approved by the Vice-Chancellor of the Committee constituted by him to design short term capsule course in lieu of Six Months course work for Jain Sadhvi Suneeti Ji and Sadhvi Suvriti Jito the extent that :

"The Admission may be allowed with exemption of NET examination and Ph.D. Entrance Test without fee with no exemption in duration of the one semester course work. The Ph.D. degree will be awarded as per UGC regulations. Seats be treated Supernumerary over and above the limit of scholars, a supervisor is entitled to".

To approve the action taken by the Vice-ChancellorUnder Section 11(5) of the University Act, 1995 for the session May/June, 2021 regarding deduction of 25 % syllabus of even semesters of UG and PG courses of affiliated degree colleges of the University and to give the following relaxation for those papers where the syllabus was divided into four units and unit wise marks of each question were of 15 marks, but first question was of 20 marks consisting of five/ten parts of short questions:-
  - Question no. 1 will be compulsory (Students will attempt three/five parts of question No. 1 out of five/ten because some of the questions might have been set from the Unit IV). Out of the remaining six questions (3 Units), candidate will have to attempt any four out of six questions.
  - ii) 4<sup>th</sup> Unit may be deleted from the syllabus and question paper.
