Som Dutt in the 97th meeting of the Executive Council.

The decision of the Executive Council vide resolution No.5 may be continued and made effective for the posts of Clerks, who were appointed/promoted in the University, on and after 07.11.2013 upto 18.07.2023 to attain the annual increment/promotion and grant of 1st ACP, instead of introduction/ implementation of condition of passing SETC (Part-I Computer Knowledge Test) and Part-II (Typing Test) conducted by the HARTON for the purpose. The audit has already been admitted the annual increments and 1st ACP of approximate 20 Clerks who have been appointed in the year 2014 and were eligible for their 1st ACP in 2022 without SETC.

2. To implement the condition of passing the SETC Part-I (Computer Knowledge Test) and Part-II (Typing Test) conducted by the HARTON instead of Computer Test conducted by the University Informatics and Computer Centre of the University, for new appointment/promotion of Clerks after 18.07.2023 for attaining annual increments/promotion and grant of ACP etc. in compliance of the clarification of State Govt. received vide their letter dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure-XCVIII Page 558 of the agenda).

Where some officers have been appointed for a specific branch or office on permanent basis, they may be replaced on rotation with some other officers/senior faculty members from amongst the University as is in the case of other administrative officers like DAA,DSW, Chief Warden, Proctor, Chairperson, etc. without affecting their emoluments, rank and seniority by the Vice Chancellor/Competent Authority as is in the case other similar position e.g. DAA, DSW, Chief Warden, Proctor, Chairpersons. There should be a guiding council in all these offices and they must meet regularly to discuss the functioning of the branch and chalk out future growth plan'.

Resolved that the above proposal be approved for the positions of Director of Sports, Director of Youth Welfare, University Librarian, Director PDUCIC, Controller of Examinations, Superintending Engineer, Director Training & Placement, etc., which are on a permanent basis.

27. Noted the decision of the State Govt. for creation of new 54 teaching and 55 non-teaching posts in Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar under Budgeted Scheme subject to the condition that the expenditure involved in the matter will be met out within the sanctioned budget of the University by relaxing in Finance Department instruction No. 5/6/2002-B&C dated 06.02.2023.
