I am directed to invite your sind attention to the State Government instruction to 96-368-III dated 25.06.1997 wherein it is observed that the Scheduled Castes/Backward Free candidates who get selected in Govt, job in the open competition on the basis of general igni (without availing any relaxation of age etc.) will have to be counted against general seats as they are open competition candidates. They will not be considered against reserved seats. However such candidates should fulfill conditions of eligibility regarding age etc. as are meant for the General in page candidates.

Hence, this department being a Nodal agency of the Government for implementation at the reservation policy issue this elarification that Government Department must follow the above instruction dated 25.06.1997. These instructions were issued in connection with the reservation policy pertaining to Govt, job. On the same analogy; the Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes capdidas who get selected/admitted in Educational/Professional/Technical Institution and acception in the open competition on the basis of their own merit, they will not be counted against the appearance reserved for Scheduled Castes Backward Classes, rather they will be treated as open espention candidates. Cases where a reserved category candidate avail relaxation say in age questif ing norms etc. then he/she will be treated against reserve category.

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The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

- i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor 5 Points
- ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 10 Points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 15 Points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 20 Points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 25 Points
- vi) Paper with impact factor>10 30 Points
- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

## Note:

Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.

For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.

\*For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b): Policy Document and 6: Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.

The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
