9. Noted the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in approving the proposal of amending the clause 1.1 of the Ordinance "Paper Setting and Evaluation", as under:-

Further resolved that the Undergraduate / Postgraduate Boards of Studies in the departments must recommend maximum number of names (not less than 10 for each paper) so that the process of evaluation may be faster and if still there remains more requirement, the COE may include extra names in consultation with the Chairperson of the department concerned.

10. Noted the action taken by the Vice Chancellor in approving the draft prospectus for admission to the courses being run by the University through distance mode for the session 2010-11 in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council and the Executive Council.

Also resolved that the university must have some effective mechanism for periodic inspection of study centres for which teams from the university / local affiliated colleges may be associated.

All the members expressed their concern over this type of laxity on the part of officials concerned with theses cases. It was, therefore, resolved that the Registrar may find out the causes of delay in these cases and pin-point the deficiencies in the next meeting. Further resolved that after the meeting of the DRC the cases of registration be finalized within a period of one month at the level of the Vice-Chancellor.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
